To Whom It May Concern:

7. Termination

This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice. Upon termination, Recipient shall cease all use of the Letter.

8. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States, without regard to conflict of law principles.

9. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether written or oral.

10. Amendments

Any amendments or modifications to this Agreement shall be in writing and signed by both parties.

11. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.

12. Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of future enforcement of that or any other provision.

13. Assignment

Recipient may not assign or transfer any rights or obligations under this Agreement without prior written consent of Provider.

14. Notices

All notices shall be in writing and delivered by hand, certified mail, or electronic mail to the addresses provided by the parties.

15. Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which constitute one and the same instrument.
